Results of our research and white paper

We have conducted intensive research in five countries including the UK, Luxembourg, Romania, Cyprus and Greece with learners, both unemployed and employed, as well as with different companies to identify the skills and competencies they are specifically looking for.

Our main objectives from this research were to:

- Reduce the employment rate for women in most of the countries
- Improve the digital skills gap between low-skilled adults and the labour market, particularly for Romania, Greece and Cyprus as we found the biggest gap in terms of digital competencies
