eSkills4All aims to train and empower adults who have a low level of digital skills to bridge the gap between digital illiteracy and the demands of the labour market. We're fighting back against skills mismatches and unemployment, not just in the technology sector, but also any industry in which digital skills can help individuals exceed, progress and succeed!

As part of this aim, we are now offering practical tools to support adults in either re-entering the labour market or improving their current digital skills, to provide further opportunities in their current role.

Our curriculum consists of five modules, each covering 3 topics, addressing various aspects of the digital world. The training course is compliant with ECVET learning outcomes.

The modules we have produced are:

5. Information and data literacy

We have delivered these modules through a hands-on, personalised, online training tool, where learners can access the modules, assess their digital competence through our quizzes, improve their knowledge and gain recognition of their skills with Open Badges!
